TIMINGS

Arrival:

Late Pick Up Fine:

<u>The</u> parents are required to pick up their children on time. Sibling can arrive early with older sibling and leave late with them without any charge. There is a late pick up charge of \$5 for every 5 minutes after 3:15 p.m.

ABSENCES

Absences:

According to state policy, students are not permitted to have more than 10% of the total school days of absences (18 days) during the academic year. This limit includes absences due to personal illness and/or travel days off. Students who exceed the allowed number of absence may be retained at their current grade-level and their reports cards may not be processed at the end of the year.

Tardiness:

Regular school attendance and punctuality are essential for a successful school experience. Coming to school 10 minutes after *your child's designated time* is considered tardy. Tardiness is recorded. An accumulation of 5 tardy days will result in a one-day absence on the student's attendance record.

Accumulation of 5 tardy days will result in notice sent home. After arrival at school, students are not allowed to leave school without permission from the office.

UNIFORMS

<u>Ilm</u> Academy School dress code is established to teach Islamic values and to encourage modesty. School uniforms are required and students are expected to be in uniform everyday unless otherwise specified.

Girls' Uniform Grades 3-8:

 (K-3 standard length) (4-8 long length).
- Khaki uniform pants–leggings are not acceptable.
- Long sleeve Polo green shirt # 8326 acceptable.
- Navy leggings are acceptable for KG 2nd grade girls.
- Solid white Amirah hijab.
- Cardigan sweater-#6300-with Ilm Academy logo.
- Sneakers, athletic shoes–closed toes (sandals, boots, or slippers are not permitted).

Boys' Uniform:

- Hunter green short/long sleeved polo shirt with Ilm Academy logo.
- Khaki uniform pants.
- Cardigan sweater-#6300-with Ilm Academy logo.
- Sneakers, athletic closed toe shoes (multi-color, sandals, boots, or slippers are not permitted).

Kufis (white only).

All Students:

- No ankle length socks. (white only–no colored socks).
- Pictures, cartoon characters, or closed hoodies on jackets not permitted. Jackets are outerwear only and students are not allowed to wear jackets in the classroom. Only uniform sweaters in the classroom.
- No cartoon characters or TV characters allowed on school items including backpacks and classroom supplies.
- No makeup, tattoos, or nail polish is permitted.
- No jewelry (necklace, ring, or bracelet).
- Strictly, no chewing gum allowed.

SMART DEVICES POLICY

Our smart devices policy is designed to ensure that students have a distraction-free learning environment.

Students are not allowed to bring smart devices which include - cell phones, smartwatches.

If a student is found with a device, it will be confiscated and returned to the parent at the end of day.
