## AMERICAN MUSLIM APPRECIATION MONTH AUGUST 2024

WHEREAS, the Ilm Academy is inspiring in their commitment to community service their student lead initiatives in support of our Fremont Human Services collection efforts resulted in their generous donations of blankets, clothing, and essential items have significantly supported our homeless neighbors, including assisting the Fremont Fire Department to aid fire victims. Their collective efforts showcase their compassion and dedication to helping those in need; and

WHEREAS, the Fremont-based American Muslim Community Foundation is an innovative and award-winning national community foundation that has committed to social basic needs, racial justice, and health equity initiatives by distributing more than \$8,000,000 to over 400 nonprofits through creating Donor Advised Funds, Giving Circles, distributing grants, partnering on sponsorships & building endowments for the American Muslim community.
